There are several claims related to the benefits of using autonomous functions within the maritime sector. These range from a reduction in human contribution to system hazards, enhancing safety, improving efficiency through optimisation of the ship design and a reduction of operating costs associated with a reduction of crew. Unfortunately, there is very little evidence to support these claims.

The presentation will therefore look at the progress being made in the development of an assurance framework that will provide 'a compelling body of evidence that without bias makes a claim for both the 'safe and unsafe' characteristics of an autonomous system when used for a defined use case in a given environment'.
